## **EANGUS AUXILIARY DELEGATE REPORT AUGUST 8-11, 2010 AMERICA'S CENTER, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI**

Saturday morning in St. Louis, MO it was very hot and humid as we picked up our packets for the conference and also pre-registered for next year's conference in Charleston, West Virginia. Sunday morning GEICO Insurance sponsored a free breakfast for conference attendees, we attended the Chapel Service, then I went to the Auxiliary First Timers' Welcome, we checked some of the booths and had lunch at the Area V Hospitality Room. We attended the first opening session at America's Center; that evening everyone went to Busch Stadium wearing their "favorite sports gear" for the "Taste of St. Louis" welcome and were treated to the usual ballgame food, hot dogs, brats, beer, pop, popcorn, etc.

Monday morning I chaired the Scholarship Committee Meeting, Romaine R. Kocer of SD won a \$1,000 scholarship; that evening was the free night; many SD folks went to Carmelo's Steak House and had good food and a fun time.

Tues. morning prior to the Auxiliary meeting at the America's Center, we had Area Caucuses, Edna and Margaret will run for Area V Directors. Committee reports were given, South Dakota received a Legislative Award and Area V is Alive newsletter received the top publication award, Wisconsin won the best State newsletter. We had our Auxiliary Luncheon at the America's Center, the food was disappointing, several awards were presented, Helen Tucker of GA received the Lifetime Membership Award. The All Area Hospitality Night was held in a park behind the old Court House, lots of good food, visiting and exchange of pins.

At our Area V Caucus on Wed. morning, it was announced Margaret Greenfield will run for the office of Auxiliary Vice-President. The budget had previously been presented and it was adopted. A representative of the Ronald McDonald House was present and received cash donations of \$1,307.20 from the auxiliaries; also many pounds of toiletries were donated. South Dakota received a second place award for the largest increase in lifetime membership. Seven Burden Bears were presented to recipients. There were several Proposed Constitutional Changes presented and they all failed. The Scholarship Committee recommended including unmarried grandchildren and step grandchildren up to age 25 to receive an Auxiliary scholarship, it was defeated. The Silent Auction was a huge success with 261 items for a total of \$5,449.00. Vivian Taylor will be the new chairman of the Lifetime Member Committee, replacing Sara Hendricks who served 27 years. Installation of officers was held, including Edna and Margaret who were sworn in as Area V Directors (Margaret was defeated in her bid for Vice-President). Billie Davis conducted a Memorial Service that included lifetime member Cecilia Halverson, deceased, of SD.

That evening the All States Banquet was held; we had been told there were 1,675 people registered for the banquet, there were folks who did not attend the banquet. Several awards were given out; Don List received an award for being the oldest person to donate blood at a blood drive held at the National Conference.

Area V had a raffle for baskets in our hospitality room, the response was wonderful. Visits with friends from SD and other states were great. Area V had a hospitality room in our hotel, we had breakfast and lunch each day and it was open afternoons and evenings. Busses took us back and forth from the hotel to the America's Center each day, it was so hot and humid it was almost impossible to be outside.

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## **EANGUS Auxiliary 37<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference Report**

The St. Louis, Missouri EANGUS Auxiliary Conference met at the America's Center from August 8-11, 2010. Vivian Taylor finished her 2-year presidency by leading general sessions on Tuesday and Wednesday.

The South Dakota delegation included Cindy Hanson, Diane Kafka, Marlys List, Sherry Blackwell and Marlene Kotab. Directors Edna Steinberg and Margaret Greenfield represented Area V.

Happenings of note were:

- the scholarship announcements. One of the \$1000 awards was presented to Romaine Kocer, Jr. from Sturgis.
- the \$957.20 donation to the local Ronald McDonald House. A thank-you was extended personally from the local manager of the program.
- the election of Vice-President Jenny Lainhart to the presidency.
- the election of a new vice-president.
- the election of Uta Vance (former Area II Director) to the office of secretary.
- the election of Cora Sower as the continuing treasurer.
- the recognition of best newsletter by Roxie Barwick of Wisconsin for our Area V Publication.
- notification of 324 total legislative contacts by South Dakota.

Two amendments were discussed and defeated – one concerning the implementation of a National Life – Associate Membership and one mandating the publication of the Executive Council Minutes.

Throughout this time, the silent auction was set up in the Exhibit Hall. South Dakota's donation was a bottle of Red-Ass Rhubarb Wine from Prairie Berry Winery of Hill City displayed in a small treasure chest-type box. It brought around \$40, so we were pleased with our contribution. 261 items were donated and the net profit was \$5449.

Other income included \$205 from cookbook sales and \$715 from the shadow pin box raffle.

Seven Burden Bears were given to members suffering a particular loss, injury or trial in the private lives.

Acquaintances were renewed with others from Area V and South Dakota's bid for the 2013 National Conference in Sioux Falls was accepted.
